Intro to Illustration is open to all students grades 9-12 while Advanced Studio is offered to juniors and seniors and AP to seniors only. The recently released feature film provides an unprecedented and rare look behind the scenes into the development of one of the modern era's most prominent and influential illustrators. Providing stunning visuals, intriguing insight and extensive commentary on Struzan's decision-making process, students would be inspired by the film's content and walk away with a stronger sense of direction for particular painting assignments and reaffirmation regarding the importance and influence of art.
