This is a federally run program that assists with job training and planning. The program is free to the students attending. We would like the funds in order to run a bus to the center and back which is about two hundred dollars. In addition, if there were additional funds left over in the PTO, we could gladly take these students on other field trips that assist in career and college exploration.
