The third grade team is requesting PTO funding in the amount of \$350.00 to cover the startup costs associated with a grade level school store. Funding would be used to purchase items necessary to get the store up and running as well as some items to begin to sell immediately. The third grade school store would sell useful, education and relevant items to students and faculty such as pencils, notebooks, erasers, shirts, sweatshirts, hats, binders, paper, etc. These items would have the TC Passios penguin logo on them and would generate school spirit among the students and faculty. The store would be operated by parents and teachers to start and then handed over to students. Ideally, the school store would be operated once or twice a week during lunch/recess time. Students would learn lifelong skills like running a small business, ordering supplies, money, teamwork, problem-solving, etc.

The third grade team would partner with the PTO to get the store up and running. Ultimately it would be the responsibility of the students with some adult supervision to operate the store.
